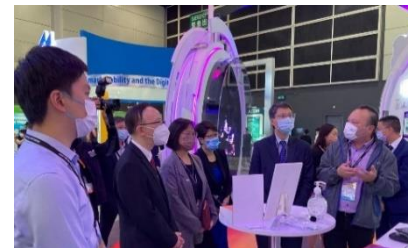

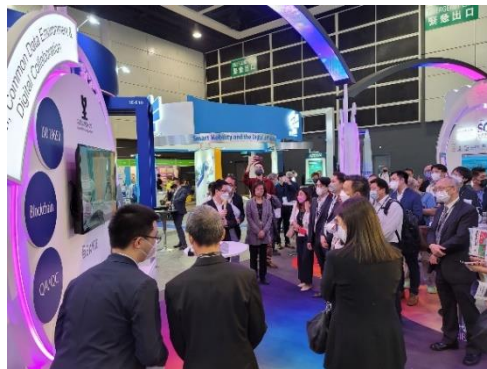

- Visitors to the SCC Pavilion included very senior representatives from Innovation and Technology Bureau, Development Bureau, Smart City Sub-committee Members of LegCo, professional institutes, foreign consulates, academics, and media representatives.

1. In Smart Property Management area, Autotoll introduced Smart Property Management solutions to offer facilities management, access control & patrol management system and electric vehicle charging solution ; and Smart Waste Management Solutions to capture real-time information of recycle bin effectively.





2. In Smart Transformation area, Dplus1 Consulting introduced BIM-enabled blockchain multifunctional platform for infrastructure lifecycle management, and platform for digital asset information, which facilitates organisations to identify insights and connections efficiently.

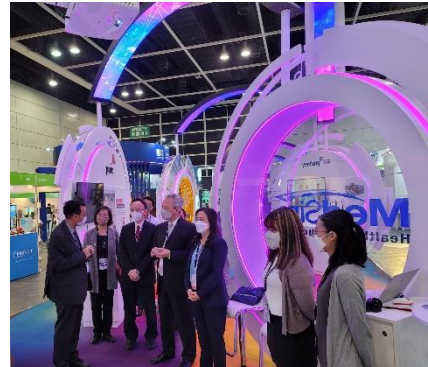
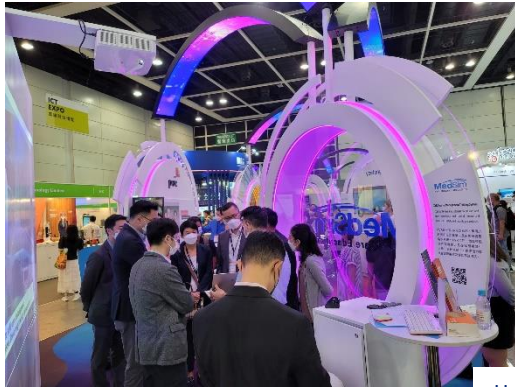
